

Central League Soccer COVID-19 Action Plan

Central League Soccer has created this COVID-19 Action Plan in accordance with guidelines set forth by EPSYA. This action plan is to be initiated in conjunction with member clubs, CDC, Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH), county health agencies, EPYSA and HIPAA guidelines and regulations. With the ever-changing conditions of pandemic, this action plan is subject to change as conditions warrant.

For a person that is presumed positive COVID-19 or that has tested positive for COVID-19:

---If a player, a coach, or a person in a player's/coach's home is presumptive positive or otherwise tests positive for COVID-19, a parent or legal guardian of the player, or the coach, should notify their home club of the occurrence and begin to follow the action plan of their respective club.

---At all times, confidentiality should remain in place following, CDC, Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH), county health agencies, EPYSA and HIPAA guidelines and regulations.

---A player or coach who is presumptive positive or has tested positive for COVID-19, or any player or coach who has been in close contact with an individual who is presumptive positive or has tested positive for COVID-19, must quarantine as required by CDC, Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH), county health agencies, and, can only return to participate in CLS activity after they have been medically cleared to return to play.

---At all times, confidentiality should remain in place for the affected individual. The home club should notify, as quickly as possible, participants who came in contact with the individual of the potential exposure, following CDC, PADOH, county health agencies, EPYSA and HIPAA guidelines and regulations.

---If the individual who is presumptive positive or tests positive for COVID-19 is a player or coach, any team(s) the individual is a member of should be shut down and shall quarantine for 14 days before resuming activities.

SUMMARY: The safety of CLS players, coaches, officials, parents and all participating members and families is our highest concern. CLS' intention with this action plan is to work with CLS member clubs to ensure that safety and keep everyone healthy.
